ORDER

Sub: Grant of Ex-gratia under Rule 75 and 76 of Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996 to Government servants, appointed on or after 01.01.2004, who dies while on duty and Ex-gratia compensation under Rule 76A to the Government servants who sustains permanent disability.


The Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996 are not applicable to the Government servants who have been appointed in Government service on or after 01.01.2004 because these Government servants are governed by the Rajasthan Civil Services (Contributory Pension) Rules, 2005.

The matter has been considered and the Governor is pleased to order to extend the provisions of Rule 75 and 76 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996 regarding grant of Ex-gratia to the family of a Government servant who has been appointed in Government service on or after 01.01.2004 and who dies while on duty and the provisions of Rule 76A of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996 to a Government servant appointed on or after 01.01.2004 and who sustains permanent disability while on election duty.

In the case of death of a Government servant while on "election duty" or who sustains permanent disability while on "election duty", the Collector of the District shall be competent to grant Ex-gratia. In cases of death other than election duty the Head of the Department shall be competent to grant Ex-gratia.

This order shall come into force w.e.f. 01.04.2011.
